The Forgotten Pharaoh

Create a 3D Shape

You will need plasticine and toothpicks for these activities.

A pyramid is not flat like a triangle. It is a solid shape that is also known as 3-Dimensional (or 3D).

1. See if you can make a square pyramid using five blobs of plasticine and eight toothpicks. (A square pyramid means that the base of the pyramid is a square shape.)
2. Using the plasticine and toothpicks, create the 3D shapes listed below and complete the chart.
