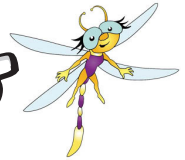




# THE LABOURS OF HERCULES



## Word Work

### Types of Words

Now you have read "The Labours of Hercules", can you work on the words in the story?

You will remember that words come in different types. The most common are **nouns** (the names of things), **verbs** (words for actions) and **adjectives** (describing words). Here is an example:

My pet **cat** (noun) **thinks** (verb) sardines are **delicious** (adjective).

Here are words from the story, all mixed up together. Can you put them in the correct column?
