Body ImageWho and What Argument?

The "speakers" in this debate have strong but quite different views. Let's try and unpick (or analyse) the reasons they put forward to support their viewpoints.

NOTE: "Contention" means the main idea put forward by a speaker or writer – the key reason they give for arguing something. "Evidence" means the fact or argument they offer which (to them) "proves" that they are right in their opinion. "Loaded language" means words or phrases that carry a lot of emotional power.
