Know your '-isms'

The Nazis had come to power in Germany and fascism (an extremist movement which celebrated authoritarianism and military power) was infecting Italy, Spain and other countries. People were beginning to talk of war.

The suffix '-ism' can be used at the end of a word to indicate that the word represents a system of beliefs (doctrine) about something, often based on religion or politics. Fascism was based on the belief that a government should be controlled by one powerful person (a dictator), preventing any opposition or freedom of speech by the people of that country.
