## Serendipity Accidental Food Inventions

The word 'serendipity' is sometimes used to describe the situation when someone makes a wonderful discovery more or less by accident.

In the information text *Serendipity*, you learnt that Coca Cola and Corn Flakes were accidental discoveries that have remained hugely popular for over a hundred years. But, these two examples are not alone. Some of your favourite foods have also been discovered more or less by accident.

**Task 1:** Write your own information text about some other popular foods that have been discovered by accident. Include the following:

- Icy poles (originally known as Popsicles and still called this in the USA)
- Sandwiches
- ♦ Chocolate Chip Cookies
- Potato chips
- ♦ Ice-cream cones

**Task 2:** Transfer your information to a slide show presentation adding images, animations and audio effects if possible.

**Task 3:** Present your information as an oral report to an appropriate audience. Use the following tips to help you present your oral report more effectively:

- **Project your voice** so that the audience can clearly hear what you are saying.
- Keep a steady, even pace making sure you don't rush through it.
- Look as though you are really interested in what you are saying.
- Keep your face animated when you are talking.
- Look up at your audience during the presentation as much as possible by either making eye contact with people or looking at a pre-selected spot at the back of the room.
- Use appropriate hand gestures to complement or emphasise certain points in the oral report.
- **Keep your feet still** trying hard not to move them or shuffle them around.
