The Power of the Stone

A birthstone (or birthday stone) is a gemstone that traditionally represents the month in which a person is born.

Task 1: Identify the birthstone for the month of your birthday. Compose an informative text about this gemstone by including the following information:

- ◇ a general description of the gemstone
- ◇ what it signifies
- ◇ where it can be found
- ◇ modern day uses
- ◇ some historical facts about the gemstone e.g. Is it associated with an ancient myth or legend? Was it believed to have magical or healing powers?

Task 2: Present this information to the class as an oral report using a Smartboard with imported pictures and digital animations to make your presentation more appealing and interesting.
