Think about the events in the story. Retell the story yourself and write it as a play. Use the following example to help you get started:

I'm Not Afraid – The Play

Setting: A large, strange castle on top of a hill

Characters: Brave Johnny
The Wise Innkeeper
A Scary monster
Narrator

Narrator: Once upon a time, there lived a young lad by the name of Johnny. He was so brave that he wasn't afraid of anything. Not snakes, not spiders, not even ghosts! He had muscles the size of bowling balls and rode a large Harley Davidson motorcycle. One day he was traveling around the countryside when he came to an inn and asked for a room for the night.

Johnny: *(loudly)* G'day mate! I'm after a room for me and a garage for my Harley.

Innkeeper: Sorry Mister, we're totally booked solid! But I have another place you could stay in, but only if you're not afraid.

Johnny: Afraid? Why should I be afraid of staying there?

Innkeeper: Well, because any traveler that has stayed in this place has never made it out alive.
